The 44th Circuit Court has a job opening for a Chief Juvenile Officer IV at the Juvenile Office in Mountain Grove, Missouri. This person will be responsible for taking charge of juveniles who come within the jurisdiction of the juvenile court, and will work with law enforcement, Division of Family Services, schools and the community on juvenile related matters. The position requires graduation from a four-year college or university with a degree in criminal justice administration, criminology, psychology, sociology, social work or related field and three years of experience as a Juvenile Officer, of which one year must have been in a supervisory capacity or one year experience as a Juvenile Officer III per Court Operating Rule 7. (The above statement represents the minimum education and experience that will be used to determine qualifications of applicants, provided equivalent substitution will be permitted in case of deficiencies of either experience or education. Education above the minimum stated may be substituted on a year for year basis for the required general experience; experience above the minimum stated may be substituted on a year for year basis for the required education.)
